Anton Gunzinger's supercomputer caused quite a stir in the IT world of the 1990s. He received a number of awards and was named one of the 100 top leaders of the 21st century by «Time» magazine. On the back of this success, he founded Supercomputing Systems Ltd. in 1993 to develop and market supercomputers. When it became apparent that the «Supercomputer» product was not going to generate sufficient income, the company transformed itself into a service provider. Today a team of 50 engineers develops products for international clients in the areas of high-performance computers, sensor systems, embedded computing and special databases. Anton Gunzinger also has a teaching assignment as a titular professor of computer architecture at the ETH Zurich. He holds a degree in electrical engineering and a PhD from the ETH Zurich.
